UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

**Students can apply for acceptance
at South African Universities
with the following:**

2 A levels and 3 subjects at GCSE level (5 individual subjects required)

OR

3 A level and 1 subject at GCSE level (4 individual subjects required)

OR

4 AS levels and 1 subject at GCSE level (5 individual subjects required)

Also, note the following:

- English Language is required at AS level
- A second language is required
- Mathematics is required

For a BSc, both Physics and Chemistry are required.

Students must choose their subjects at International GCSE level according to the following rules in order to comply with South African university entrance requirements once they have completed AS and A levels:

- **1 subject from Group 1** (First language)
- **1 subject from Group 2** (Second language)
- **1 subject from Group 3:** Mathematics is compulsory in South Africa.

Thereafter, they may choose the remaining 3 International GCSE subjects from any group.
